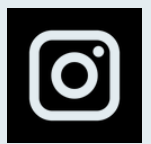

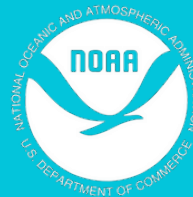
WHY APPLY?
